

So, it's time for another membership year. Your renewal forms are ready, if you were at the September meeting you received them there, otherwise they will be coming in the mail. We've kept the prices the same, \$30 for renewals with work hours, \$40 for new memberships or renewals without hours. Long-timers in the club can remember back when we had 250 families in the Snobirds which was also our limit. Members without the work hours not only paid the higher rate, but went to the end of any waiting list and perhaps didn't get to join for that year.
