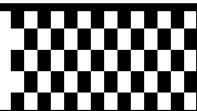

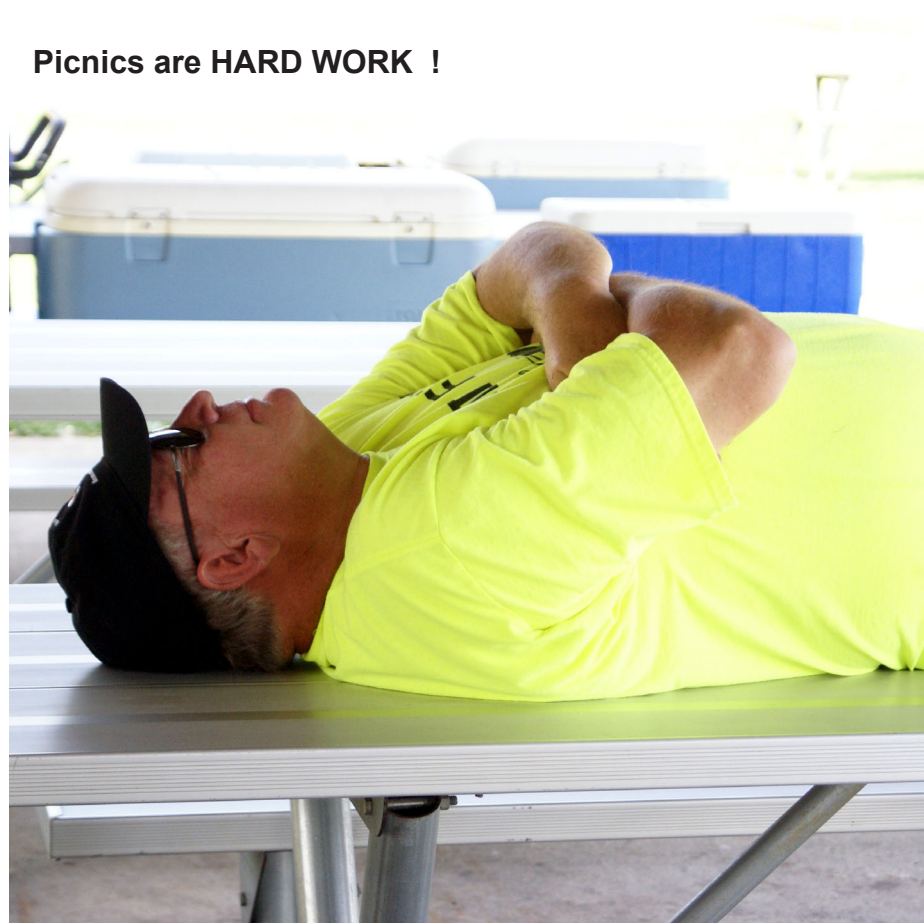

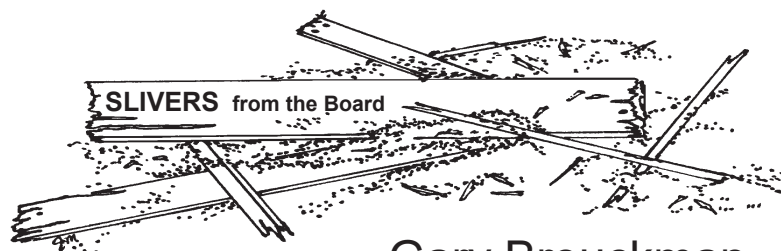

Summer events are winding down - if you weren't there you missed a lot of fun. The picnic was very well attended this year, and the food was great, as well as those home-made desserts that folks brought.

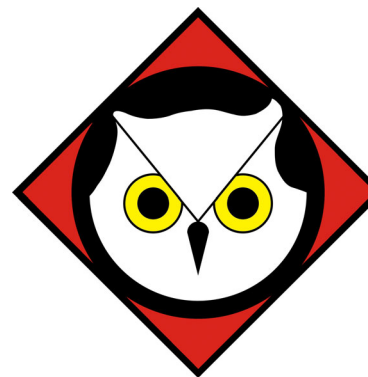
The Corn Roast went well - it's an added incentive to show up for the Board Elections, but we all had a good time.
